
# **Talking Teaching and Learning**





#### Recap of how to use 'The Lobby Function' on Teams.

Why use it? The lobby prevents students entering a meeting without your permission. It ensures a smoother start, as you have more control.


Create and populate your teams meeting, as normal and save.

Return to the class home page and where the meeting is now listed: hover over the three dots and click on 'view meeting details.'

Towards the top right-hand side of the screen, click 'Meeting Options.'

A webpage will open. On the dropdown menu, next to 'who can bypass the lobby' select 'only me.' Save this change.

(These steps need to be completed for each meeting.)


# **Microsoft Teams Tip:**
