The House system allows us to feel part of a bigger family at Ecclesfield School.

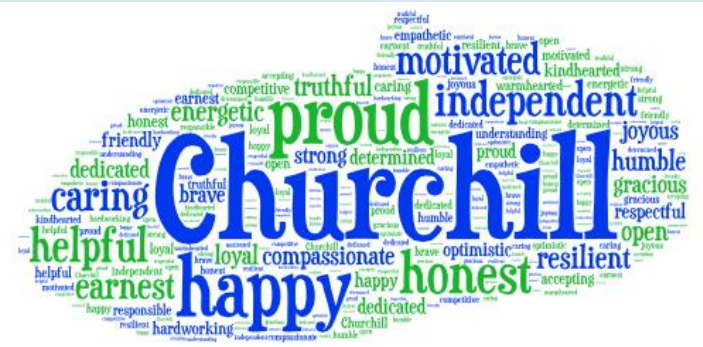
Our House colour is **GREEN** and our house logo is here:

(Form) within a larger family (House).

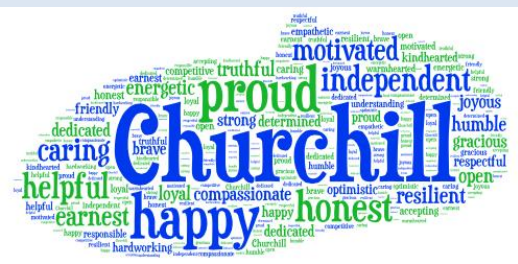
Strive to achieve your best at all time. Quizzes, sports,

Planners – need to be kept free of graffiti and signed every week by a Parent/Guardian. I will sign them every Monday.

Assembly – Wednesday is our assembly day. You need to come to your form room as usual before the bell at 8.40am.

Lates – Registration starts at 8.40am. If you arrive after the second bell you will be classed as LATE and required to attend a 30 min detention on the same day in LMH.

If you fail to attend you will be given a one hour SLT detention on either a Wednesday or Friday. If you do not attend this you may well be excluded.

It is your responsibility to arrive to school on time.

Uniform and Equipment – All students need to be in correct uniform and be equipped for lessons.
