What it looks like

Students are allowed to wear tailored, black shorts like this:



- Made of school trouser material i.e. no linen, no cargo, no sports or tracksuit material.
- Closer to knee length

These can be bought from shops like ASDA, Primark, Next and M & S.

In Summary



- Tailored, black short – trouser like material i.e. no linen, sports short, cargo shorts etc.
- Shorts must be closer to knee length and be appropriate for wear in a professional setting.
- Shorts must be worn with a school shirt tucked in and a school tie
- Only non-sports branded footwear (black, polishable shoes as per school policy) with black or white socks will be permitted. No trainers will be permitted.
- Only school jumpers or jackets are to be worn – no hoodies
