Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our ongoing efforts to ensure a safe and accessible environment for all members of our school community, we would like to remind you of the importance of adhering to parking regulations when using the school car park, particularly concerning the disabled parking bays.

Disabled parking bays (marked in blue)

These bays are reserved exclusively for individuals who display a Blue Badge. It is crucial that these spaces remain available for those who genuinely need them and we would kindly ask that you:

- 1. Do not park in the disabled parking bays unless you have a valid Blue Badge clearly displayed.**
- 2. Do not use these bays when waiting to collect students.**

Please help us maintain accessibility for those who rely on these spaces. Your co-operation is greatly appreciated and contributes to the overall well-being of our school community.

Pick up/drop off:

Where possible, please do not enter the school site when dropping off/collecting students, instead arrange to meet away from the school grounds. If this is unavoidable, please be considerate to other vehicles by only using the designated parking spaces. The old bus parking bays may be used for pick up/drop off, however to prevent congestion please only use the bays highlighted in green below. **Please do not wait in the red areas.** If there is no space in car park, please leave via the normal exit and make alternative parking arrangements. If found to be parked in the red area, you may be asked to leave the carpark. There have been a number of near misses over the last year, all of which were avoidable had cars followed the above guidance.

Can I also remind you that next Monday the 3rd of February is a Staff Training Day.
