Roofing Works at Ecclesfield School

I am writing to inform you that essential roofing and cladding works will be taking place at Ecclesfield School, commencing during the May half term and continuing for approximately 9–12 weeks.

The school will remain fully open throughout the programme of works and will continue to operate as a live environment. While some disruption is unavoidable, careful planning is in place to minimise any impact on teaching and learning ensure the works are completed within the required timescale, and most importantly to maintain the safety of students, staff and visitors.

All contractors working on site operate under strict health and safety controls. Work areas will be clearly marked and securely fenced. No works will take place near the school halls while exams are in progress.

As part of this programme, the bottom section of the overflow car park will be used as a contractor welfare compound. This area will be securely fenced off and is only accessible to site contractors.

Students will be reminded of expectations during form time. We would be grateful for your support in reinforcing this message at home. Students must behave sensibly around any working areas and must not enter or cross into fenced-off or restricted zones under any circumstances.

As the works progress, arrangements may change. We will keep parents informed should any updates be required.
