


Word of the Week is launched and shared with students every Monday. Students are encouraged to use the word to widen their tier two vocabulary ready for their GCSE exams.

Optional **ROUTES training** is positive – colleagues give up their own time to opt into training which is personalised to them.






In February, Sarah Chamberlain launches the **Observe Me project**. This involves members of staff from different departments informally observing colleagues based on staff members different strengths.
