




For this task you need to write a letter to your MP about a local issue that you feel strongly about.

Your letter should be set out like a letter with an appropriate salutation and closing and consist of 3 paragraphs:

- Explain the issue.
- Why you think something should be done about it.
- What do you think should be done about it.

Your letter must include at least 5 of the following:

- A sentence that starts with a Verb.
- A sentence that is 8 words long.
- A 4-syllable word.
- A sentence that contains a rhetorical question.
- A sentence that contain alliterations
- A sentence with 3 adjectives.
- A sentence that contains a simile
- A 3-syllable word
- A sentence that contains a metaphor.
- A sentence that contains onomatopoeia
