So this is it! Your final week as Y11s! How quickly has it gone?

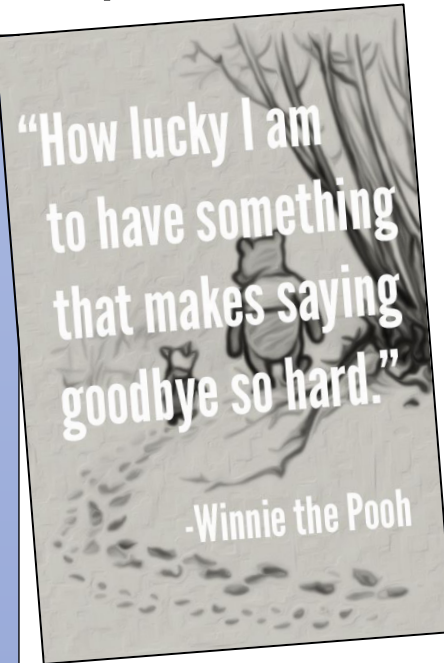
