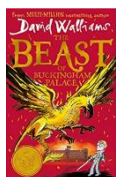

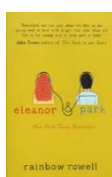

## A to Z of Mindfulness

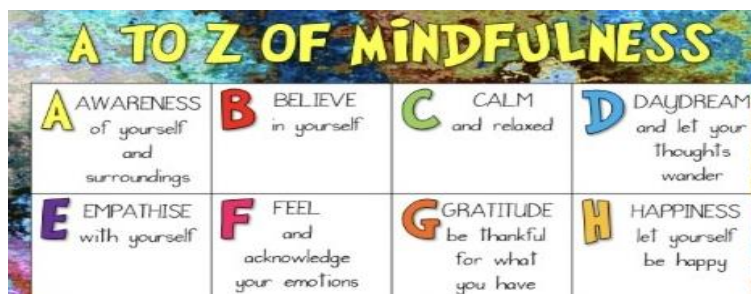

<b>English</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ <b>Poetry challenge</b> - Leave your family a note on the fridge: write the first line of a poem and get them to continue it or leave them a topic that they have to write about.</li> <li>❖ <b>Pobble 365</b> – Check out for inspiration to help you write. Choose a date and see what image and ideas it gives you for that day - I like April 1st!</li> <li>❖ <b>Read all about it!</b> Have a go at becoming a newspaper reporter - create engaging articles by using the student newspaper 'The Day' website for inspiration.</li> </ul>
<b>Drama</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ <b>Lip Sync Battle</b> - Put together a playlist of your favourite songs and mime along. You can film your lip synchs and challenge your friends. Don't forget to use exaggerated facial expressions and movements.</li> <li>❖ <b>Charades</b> - Gather the family around and put your mime skills to the test. Remember to use clear facial expressions and gestures as you take it in turns to act out books, films, or show titles for each other.</li> </ul>
<b>MFL</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ <b>Peppa Pig</b> - Watch an episode on YouTube in French/German/Spanish.</li> <li>❖ <b>Football</b> - Adopt a French/German/Spanish football team and support them through the season!</li> <li>❖ <b>Research</b> a French/German/Spanish festival.</li> <li>❖ <b>Celebrity</b> - Find out about a famous French/German/Spanish celeb.</li> </ul>
