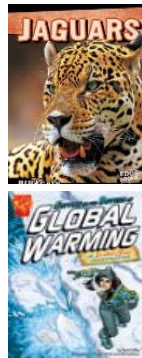

Turn the grill to high, put the pittas on the grill rack and heat for 1 min. 2. Slice the mozzarella into 5 pieces. 3. Remove pitta and spread 1 tsp. of pesto on each. Add a slice of mozzarella. Pile the ham on top so it looks ruffled. Add some extra mozzarella and a sprinkle of black pepper. 4. Return to the grill rack for 3-4 mins.
