







This week Mrs Bird has read **D-Day dog** by Tom Palmer.

Shortlisted for the Sheffield shorter novel category, this book will appeal particularly to Y7/8 students. Based on real life events from WW2 and the part animals played on the battlefields, it links with modern day conflicts and a boy named Jack who visits Normandy on a school trip determined to discover the fate of a soldier and his dog. This thought provoking read sympathetically answers some difficult questions about war.

For example, if your birthday is November 26, your coordinates could be 11°N, 26°E. Plot your birthday coordinates on a map.
