

Knowledge Packs

What is a knowledge pack?

At the beginning of each half term, you will be given a knowledge pack. Each one contains a knowledge organiser for all of the subjects you study.

Knowledge organisers include the key facts, core information, diagrams, models and subject specific vocabulary and definitions for a particular topic. They will look slightly different for each subject area.

How can you use your knowledge organisers at home?

- ❖ Use the look, cover, write and check method to learn key information. Cover up part of a knowledge organiser, write it out from memory, then self-check and correct any spelling mistakes, missing bits or misunderstandings.



- ❖ Use a knowledge organiser to create revision cards, mind maps, quizzes and other revision resources.
- ❖ Use a knowledge organiser to support with learning the meaning of key vocabulary for the topic.
- ❖ Your family and friends can quiz you using a knowledge organiser to check your understanding.
- ❖ Use a knowledge organiser to support with completing your home learning. On the other hand, use to check your home learning.
- ❖ Use a knowledge organiser to support with learning the spellings of key vocabulary.
- ❖ Turn the information into pictures or diagrams to help learn it.
- ❖ You can use previous knowledge organisers to discuss how your new knowledge links and how it builds upon previous knowledge.

When will you use the knowledge pack?

- ❖ You must bring your knowledge pack to school every day.
- ❖ It is part of your daily school equipment.
- ❖ You will use your knowledge pack to support your learning in lessons and at home when completing home learning and independent study.

What are the benefits of using a knowledge organiser?

- ❖ They show you the 'bigger picture' of the topic and subject you are studying.
- ❖ They support you in lessons with your learning and at home with independent study.
- ❖ They help you to link your learning together so that you know and remember more.
- ❖ They support you with learning, revising and remembering key content, vocabulary, definitions and knowledge.
- ❖ They support you with your learning if you miss a lesson.
