

## **Our Remote Learning Commitment**

## April 2021 Individual Student Isolation



Remote learning will follow the curriculum plan for each subject and will be aligned to what is being taught in school at the time. If a student is required to self-isolate, Ecclesfield will provide remote learning as detailed below. There is an expectation that the work is completed by the student so that self-isolation does not leave students behind other peers in school.

Students should try to follow their normal timetable whilst working from home.

Students will receive work in each subject per learning cycle (each week). This will be uploaded onto Microsoft Teams as an assignment but your child may also be invited to join a live lesson.

Students will receive some feedback on work, misconceptions and success for their work in each subject within the cycle.

Students must keep up and complete all work set as learning will continue and will not necessarily be revisited once they return to school.

Students should submit work via Microsoft Teams only.

As staff are continuing to teach full timetables in school, please be aware that work may not be set immediately after we have been informed a child must self-isolate. This is especially prevalent during the first few hours/first day of remote learning. Our colleagues will endeavour to upload work as soon as possible and we thank you for your continued support.

If a student has difficulty accessing a computer, tablet or phone at home and/or has not internet access to receive/stream learning, please contact the school so that alternative arrangements can be made as soon as possible.
