Individual Student Isolation



Remote learning will follow the curriculum plan for each subject and will be aligned to what is being taught in school at the time. If a student is required to self-isolate, Ecclesfield will provide remote learning as detailed below. There is an expectation that the work is completed by the student so that self-isolation does not leave students behind other peers in school.

Students should follow their normal timetable whilst working from home

Students will receive work in each subject per learning cycle (2 weeks). This will most likely be uploaded onto Microsoft Teams but may also be emailed out to your child.

Students will receive some feedback on work, misconceptions and success for their work in each subject within the cycle.

Students must keep up and complete all work set as learning will continue and will not necessarily be revisited once they return to school

Students can submit work either through email or via Microsoft Teams

If a student has difficulty accessing a computer, tablet or phone at home and/or has not internet access to receive/stream learning, please contact the school so that alternative arrangements can be made as soon as possible.
