WHEN IS EXAMS RESULTS DAY?

Thursday 22nd August 2024 9am – 11am in Lady Mabel Hall. (From 11am onwards, results can be collected from reception.)

I CAN'T COLLECT MY RESULTS IN PERSON, WHAT CAN I DO?

A nominated person can collect your results on your behalf, they must bring a letter signed by you and photographic proof of ID.

Alternatively, you can send in a A4 stamped addressed envelope so we can post them out to you.

I AM NOT HAPPY WITH MY RESULTS, WHAT CAN I DO?

There will be members of staff to talk to on the day who can advise you on what to do next. There will also be a 'Post results Services' form within your results pack, which details several options available to you. Please discuss with a member of staff before requesting any post results services.
