

Subject: PSHCE (Personal, Social, Health, Careers and Economic Education).

- PSHCE is a new subject being taught from September 2023 and replaces previous SMSC lessons.
- In years 7, 8, 9 and 10, students will follow the curriculum outlined below, and they will receive one lesson a week.
- In year 11, students will receive one lesson a fortnight, and they will be taught lessons that address gaps in their knowledge due to them not having benefitted from the full curriculum because PSHCE was introduced as a new subject in Year 10.
- In 2025-26, Year 11 students will receive a lesson a week in line with the rest of the school.
