Revising for Geography – 6 easy steps!!

Step 1: Start by choosing an exam (Paper 1, Paper 2, or Paper 3)

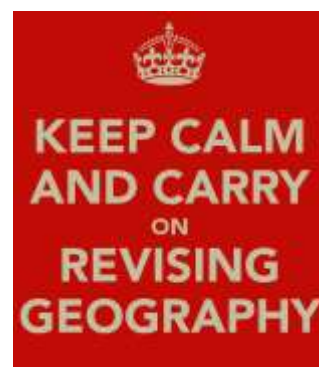
Step 2: Narrow the exam paper down, choose a section E.g. A, B or C

Step 3: Now choose a topic within a section. E.g. Section A, Climate Change

Step 4: Use your class book and revision guide to help you revise.

Step 5: Decide how you are going to revise E.g. Mind maps, revision cards, revision posters, answering exam questions. Complete one of these tasks for the chosen topic.

Step 6: Now make your revision active. Ask someone to quiz you on the content using the revision resource you have made. **Repeat these steps until you have revised all sections in each of the exams.**



What do I need to revise for paper 1?

- There are 3 sections in paper 1 (*section A, B + C*)
- The exam is 1 hr 30 mins
- 88 marks
- 35% of the GCSE

Section A: The challenge of natural hazards (33 marks)

In this section you will be examined on:

- ✓ Tectonic Hazards
- ✓ Weather Hazards
- ✓ Climate Change

***You must answer all the questions**

Section B: The Living World (25 marks)

In this section you will be examined on:

- ✓ Global Ecosystems
- ✓ Tropical Rainforests
- ✓ Deforestation
- ✓ Hot deserts

***You must answer all the questions**

Section C: The changing economic world (30 marks)

In this section you will be examined on:

- ✓ Economic Development + quality of life
- ✓ Reducing the global development gap (e.g. tourism)
- ✓ NEE study (Nigeria)
- ✓ UK economy

***You must answer all the questions**

Note* The Changing Economic World is human geography and will be examined on paper 2.

However, on this occasion we have merged the topics you have studied to create 1 exam paper.

You have covered the material for section A + B in Y9.

We are going to revise this content as a class after February half term.

You will also need to use your Y9 class book to help revise and prepare for section A + B.
